# Inner Wisdom Community Projects

## Project Africa

Building health and education community centers in Central Africa dedicated to improving the quality of life for community members affected by extreme poverty, disease, conflict and lack of basic education and healthcare.

Each center will have a small school with basic classrooms, a recreational field, volunteers quarters, adult vocational center, a health clinic, and a rehabilitation center.

## Project Morning Star

Constructing a bilingual school in Honduras in 2010.

The Morning Star Bilingual School began in Feb., 2006 in the community of Sula, in the state of Santa Barbara, Honduras, and is the first bilingual school in this area.

The school currently has no formal classrooms, desks, or safe place to play for the students. It currently holds classes outdoors on a shaded property on the main street of Sula.

Inner Wisdom will travel with a group of construction teams from January 2010 to April 2010 to construct a new school, community recreation center and teachers housing. This new school will be accessible to neighboring communities of San Marcos, Azacualpa, Casa Quemada, Ciruelo, La Flecha and La Entrada.

## School to School

Connecting American school children and their schools with developing international schools such as the Morning Star Bilingual School in Honduras, Inner Wisdom acts as a school liaison establishing partnerships. The American schools interact through written communication with their partner schools and hold fund-raisers to gather much needed supplies.

## Local Community Support

Helping local Vermont families experiencing tough economic pressures by providing shelter, holiday meals, gifts for special occasions, and much needed emotional support.
